C1	Blood supply to the head, pituitary gland, scalp, bone of the face, brain, inner and middle ear, sympathetic nervous system.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Headaches</li> <li>nervousness</li> <li>insomnia</li> <li>head colds</li> <li>high blood pressure</li> <li>migraine</li> <li>headaches</li> <li>nervous breakdowns</li> <li>amnesia</li> <li>chronic tiredness</li> <li>dizziness</li> </ul>
C2	Eyes, optic nerves, auditory nerves, sinuses, mastoid bones, tongue, forehead.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sinus trouble</li> <li>allergies</li> <li>pain around the eyes</li> <li>earache</li> <li>fainting spells</li> <li>certain cases of blindness</li> <li>crossed eyes</li> <li>deafness</li> </ul>
C3	Cheeks, outer ear, face bones, teeth, infacial nerve.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Neuralgia</li> <li>neurites</li> <li>acne or pimples</li> <li>eczema</li> </ul>
C4	Nose, lips, mouth, eustachian tube	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hay fever</li> <li>runny nose</li> <li>hearing loss</li> <li>adenoids</li> </ul>
C5	Vocal cords, neck glands, pharynx	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Laryngitis</li> <li>hoarseness</li> <li>throat conditions such as sore throat or guinsy</li> </ul>
C6	Neck muscles, shoulders, tonsils.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stiff neck</li> <li>pain in upper arm</li> <li>tonsillitis</li> <li>chronic cough</li> <li>croup</li> </ul>
C7	Thyroid gland, bursae in the shoulders, elbows.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bursitis</li> <li>colds</li> <li>thyroid conditions</li> </ul>
T1	Arms from the elbows down, including hands, wrists, and fingers, esophagus and trachea.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Asthma</li> <li>cough</li> <li>difficult breathing</li> <li>shortness of breath</li> <li>pain in lower arms and hands</li> </ul>
T2	Heart, including its valves and covering, coronary and arteries.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Functional hearth conditions and certain chest conditions</li> </ul>
T3	Lungs, bronchial tubes, pleura, chest, breast.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bronchitis</li> <li>pleurisy</li> <li>pneumonia</li> <li>congestion</li> <li>influenza</li> </ul>
T4	Gallbladder, common duct.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Gallbladder conditions</li> <li>jaundice</li> <li>shingles</li> </ul>
T5	Liver, solar plexus, circulation (general).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Liver conditions</li> <li>fevers</li> <li>blood pressure problems</li> <li>poor circulations</li> <li>arthritis</li> </ul>
T6	Stomach	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stomach troubles including</li> <li>nervous stomach</li> <li>indigestion</li> <li>heartburn</li> <li>dyspepsia</li> </ul>
T7	Pancreas, duodenum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ulcers</li> <li>gastritis</li> </ul>
T8	Spleen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lowered resistance</li> </ul>
T9	Adrenal and suprarenal glands	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allergies</li> <li>hives</li> </ul>
T10	Kidneys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kidney troubles</li> <li>hardening of the arteries</li> <li>chronic tiredness</li> <li>nephritis</li> <li>pyelitis</li> </ul>
T11	Kidneys, and kidney ureters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Skin conditions such as acne</li> <li>pimples</li> <li>eczema</li> <li>boils</li> </ul>
T12	Small Intestines, lymph circulation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rheumatism</li> <li>gas pains</li> <li>certain types of sterility</li> </ul>
L1	Large intestines, inguinal rings.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Constipation</li> <li>colitis</li> <li>dysentery</li> <li>diarrhea</li> <li>some rupture of hernias</li> </ul>
L2	Appendix, abdomen, upper leg.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cramps</li> <li>difficulty breathing</li> <li>minor varicose veins</li> </ul>
L3	Sex organs, uterus, bladder, knees.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bladder troubles</li> <li>menstrual troubles such as painful</li> <li>or irregular periods</li> <li>miscarriages</li> <li>bed wetting</li> <li>impotency</li> <li>changes of life symptoms</li> <li>many knee pains</li> </ul>
L4	Prostate gland, muscles of the lower back, sciatic nerve.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sciatica</li> <li>lumbago</li> <li>difficult painful or too</li> <li>frequent urination</li> <li>backaches</li> </ul>
L5	Lower legs, ankles, feet.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Poor circulation in the legs</li> <li>swollen ankles</li> <li>weak ankles and arches</li> <li>cold feet</li> <li>weakness in the legs</li> <li>leg cramps</li> </ul>
SACRUM	Hip bones, buttocks.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sacroiliac conditions</li> <li>spinal curvatures</li> </ul>
COCCYX	Rectum, anus.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hemorrhoids (piles)</li> <li>pruritus (itching)</li> <li>pain at end of spine on sitting</li> </ul>
